Inclusive Practice Award for Dyslexia



The following courses, training and teaching are available to support schools in gaining the Specialist Inclusion Team (SIT) Inclusive Practice Award for Dyslexia. They will be delivered by experienced **specialist dyslexia teachers** from SIT. Schools can purchase individual training or access different options using time within their already purchased SIT annual package. Please contact Kelly.Parkin@rotherham.gov.uk with any enquiries.

Understanding Dyslexia and strategies to Support	Training to raise awareness of the difficulties that pupils with dyslexia may experience and strategies to support access to the curriculum. A half day INSET or can be over 2 staff meetings. Suitable for all staff, parents/carers and governors.	£350 or 6 hours from SIT package
Early Identification and Intervention	A training session to raise awareness of the early signs of specific literacy difficulties within KS1 and appropriate intervention. Can be delivered as a staff meeting. Suitable for all KS1 staff, parents/carers and governors.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Dyslexia and Revision Workshop	Increase understanding about the difficulties that students with dyslexia may face and share strategies and practical revision tips for KS3 and KS4 students. Suitable for staff, parents/carers and students.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Accessible Reading	Training specifically focusing on how reading materials and activities in school can be accessible for struggling readers. Can be delivered as a staff meeting. Suitable for all staff.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Delivery of Targeted Intervention	A practical session with support staff to discuss the procedures needed in a structured literacy intervention and model multisensory activities to support the delivery of the sessions. Suitable for all support staff delivering 1:1 literacy support.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Pupil Workshop	Whole class or group session with pupils to raise awareness of the difficulties some pupils may face, with a focus on the strengths and successes that can come from being dyslexic. Suitable for pupils in KS2 and KS3.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Parent/Carer Workshop	An informal meeting for parents/carers of pupils with dyslexia to give a short overview of dyslexia and opportunities to share experiences and offer support. Suitable for parents/carers.	£180 or 3 hours from SIT package
Leadership/ SENDCo Support	Working with SENDCo/school staff to support and advise where appropriate. Examples include; observations of lessons /interventions, advice on environments, review of reading books and resources and targeted intervention support. Suitable for school leaders.	Cost or time as per request

Please note that the Skills Education Group (SEG) accredited training is run over a full term and requires a minimum number of participants for it to run.

<p>Accredited Dyslexia Course</p>	<p>SEG accredited Intermediate level training: 6 full days and one-half day of training over a term. It also includes the delivery of a dyslexia intervention programme to a student within your school/setting. The course aims to develop the knowledge and understanding of dyslexia as well as how to plan and deliver interventions for pupils with dyslexic needs.</p> <p>Suitable for staff delivering interventions.</p>	<p>Six days over the term</p> <p>£700</p>
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Please note that places for READ are limited and a term of support is allocated through a referral process.

<p>Rotherham Enhanced Action for Dyslexia (READ)</p>	<p>READ is a traded outreach provision for pupils experiencing specific and persistent literacy difficulties, despite appropriate interventions in school/setting. It is available to pupils in mainstream settings, in alternative provision or special schools (with or without an EHCP) through a referral process. The READ programme is delivered by highly experienced and trained staff within the SI Team who work with pupils on a 1:1 basis in their school/setting. 2 READ sessions a week is highly recommended to support the level of overlearning required.</p> <p>Suitable for children in Y3 to Y10.</p>	<p>12 weeks of 1:1 teaching sessions with identified pupil</p> <p>1 x 1-hour session a week = £811 2 x 1-hour sessions a week = £1622</p>
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<p>Initial meeting at school with SENDCo. Half day visit to school. Report produced highlighting strengths and any recommended actions. Final meeting at school and certificate.</p>	<p>£350 or 6 hours from SIT Package</p>
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
