Costings for a course run by Qualified BSL Tutor, HI Team and Communication Support Worker.

No costs for:

- Deaf child (first time)
- Parent or Carer of a deaf child (first time)
- Other family member of deaf child (first time)
- RMBC HI Team Staff (first time)

£219 is chargeable for the below and includes discount:

- Staff at a Rotherham maintained school or part of an Academy Trust, directly working with a deaf child.
- Rotherham school staff interested (where there is a deaf child in school).
- Rotherham Speech and Language Therapist working with deaf children at Resource or with deaf children.
- Rotherham Sight & Sound Staff.

***Exam, registration, and approval fees payable. Exam cost: 201- £49
202- £60 203-£60. Registration fee and Approval fee: £50
We have made no charge for the course.***

£398.00 Full charge for people outside these categories:

- 30% discount applied for under 18-year-olds

Cost includes exam fee for Units 201, 202, 203, Registration Fee, Staff Costs and Annual Approval Fee

Allocation of places

Priority is given to Children, Parents and Families, then schools working with a deaf child.

Places are then allocated on a first come first served basis.

Attendance

Attendees are requested to attend the full 30-week course in order for exam readiness.

Replacement Certificates are available from Signature at a cost of £25 each.

Additional exam practice sessions with Deaf Instructor are available on request subject to availability. There is a cost for the Deaf Instructor's time in addition to the course price. Please ask for a quotation should you wish to access this opportunity.
